This week's sale was hot and humid but nevertheless there were noteworthy results: A 1913 sovereign made £330, even in its good condition, this was a good price. A mid century teak and walnut bedroom suite proved that this is the buoyant area for furniture, making £280, and a set of three light oak tables made £75, but as usual antique furniture feels undervalued ~ a decent regency sideboard was had for £70 . Toys sell well, though Scalextric sets can be lackluster, so £50 was good for a boxed set with a few accessories. We had a collection of tools from one man who was a train-coach builder, which made £110 and, on a similar vein, a fairly basic wooden workshop cabinet made £80.
